Chief Yuodis called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

### Old Business

Chief Yuodis reported there is now an extension cord on Unit 3734.

Chief Yuodis stated the paging system is up and running. Everyone that filled out the form are getting the pages. Discussion followed.

Jason Rivera asked about the soft drink machine and wanted to know if we were getting rid of the machine. Bill Weiss stated no. Chief Yuodis stated we have been having everyone coming in and getting soft drinks and water, even though there were not on a fire run or at training and these are getting very expensive. Discussion followed.

Chief Yuodis explained that Bob Dooley wanted the 3704 number so he thought the only fair way to decide this was to let the entire department, if they were eligible, to vote. I passed and the 3704 number is being retired.

Chief Yuodis reported the stone out front for Terry Cannon is suppose to be done by the middle of September. Pat Staudenheimer asked is there anyone in charge of that area; it is very small to put 2 markers in there. Adam Jones stated David O'Brien is in charge of landscaping. Pat asked if we were going to make the area a little bigger. Discussion followed. Pat asked if, when the marker is placed, is there going to be some kind of ceremony or dedication. Chief Yuodis stated he has thought about this, on September 29<sup>th</sup> there is a Kentucky Fallen Firefighter Memorial Service in Frankfort at 11:00 AM and he thought about doing something the following Tuesday, if we have the stone in, which will be October 5, 2010. Discussion followed.

Chief Yuodis stated Patrick Hill is out; he is the person that started the barn fire on Six Mile Lane. Steve Wolfe stated he has visited St. Martha's and wanted to volunteer to work there and volunteer everywhere, so he is in the neighborhood.

Jason Rivera asked are we going to have a new fire department picture made. Adam Jones stated there was one made in 2004. Discussion followed. Chief Yuodis will check into this.

Jake Barker asked if we retired 3737. Chief Yuodis stated no. Jake asked should we retire 3737 since we are retiring 3704, Steve Harrington's last call was 3737. Discussion followed. Chief stated we will send this to the crew for a vote. Jake made a motion to take a roster vote of yes retire 3737 or

we do not retire 3737, seconded by Jason Rivera. Discussion followed. Adam Jones asked about making our next engine 3737 in honor of Steve Harrington. Discussion followed. Jake retracted his motion and Jason retracted his second. Adam Jones made a motion that the next engine we get it be allowed to be numbered 3737 in memorial of Steve Harrington and who ever else we choose, seconded by Jason Rivera. Motion carried.
