Title: Outside Training & Fire School Attendance

<b>Section</b>	<b>Instruction</b>
1.	All Officers, Sergeants, and Instructors shall be certified on NFPA 1403. The Training Bureau shall make available 1403 classes on a recurring basis so that new Sergeants and instructors can be certified.
2.	When any Buechel Fire Personnel attend a live fire training session outside of our district, a NFPA 1403 Instructor from the Buechel Fire Protection District shall accompany those personnel to the training. If that instructor sees anything improper or unsafe, they shall cease Buechel Fire District's participation at that point and submit in writing a report to the Chief Training Officer immediately.
3.	Personnel attending live fire training classes taught by State Fire/Rescue Instructors at Fire Schools may be exempted at the discretion of the Chief Training Officer.
4.	Anyone participating in a fire school where Buechel issued gear is needed shall request in writing to use the necessary equipment. This request is made to the Chief Training Officer for recommendation to the Chief for approval or denial. The request must be done (seven) 7 days prior to the training date.
5.	Any instructor who is requested to help teach at a live burn, fire school, or other outside training must be requested in writing or electronically by the host department. Request should be made to the Chief Training Officer of the Buechel Fire Protection District.
6.	Any additional instructors needed should be requested by the lead instructor from Buechel taking part in the exercise. This should also include all needed equipment.
7.	Any request for equipment from the Buechel Fire Protection District shall also be made in writing to the Chief Training Officer who shall recommend approval or denial of the request to the chief.
8.	In the absence of the Chief, approval can be made by the Assistant Chief or the Chief's designee.
9.	All equipment borrowed shall be listed on the approved form and signed out by the Shift Captain. The Chief Training Officer or Chief will notify all Shift Captains if equipment or gear usage has been approved.
