Title: Classes of Uniforms

	<p>The fire district has four (4) classes of uniforms, Class A, B, C and D.</p> <p>The Class-A uniform is issued to the Chief Officers.</p> <p>The Class-B, C, and D uniforms are issued upon satisfactory completion of the probationary period to all firefighters.</p> <p><u>CLASS-A</u> This uniform consists of: Dark blue long dress coat, black tie, long or short sleeve white shirt, dark blue trousers, black belt and military style dress hat. (These items are provided by the Fire District).</p> <p>When wearing this uniform the member shall provide a white t-shirt, dark blue socks and black dress shoes.</p> <p><u>CLASS-B</u> This uniform consist of: Dark blue short sleeve shirt, dark blue t-shirt, dark blue trousers and black belt. (<i>These items are provided by the Fire District</i>). (<i>White shirts and white t-shirt for the Chief and Assistant Chief</i>)</p> <p>When wearing this uniform the member shall wear dark blue socks and black shoes.</p> <p>The military style hat is the only issued hat to be worn with this uniform.</p> <p><u>CLASS-C</u> This uniform consists of: Dark blue trousers, dark blue uniform shirt w appropriate sewn on insignia, t-shirt, and black belt. (<i>These items are provided by the Fire District</i>).</p> <p>When wearing this uniform the member shall provide dark blue socks and black shoes.</p> <p>The Fire District issued ball cap may be worn with this uniform.</p> <p><u>CLASS-D</u> This uniform consists of: Dark blue trousers, t-shirt or Golf Shirt or Sweat-shirt, and black belt. (<i>These items are provided by the Fire District</i>).</p> <p>When wearing this uniform the member shall provide dark blue socks and black shoes.</p> <p>The Fire District issued ball cap may be worn with this uniform.</p>
