Title: Wearing of Uniform

Section	Instruction
	<p>The Class A uniform is to be worn for special occasions such as awards ceremonies, funeral details, and at the discretion of the Chief Officers.</p> <p>The Class B uniform is to be worn to fire district functions or related activities. <i>Examples: The Firefighters Association Meetings, The Crusade For Children or any other occasion deemed necessary by the Chief.</i></p> <p>The Class C uniform is to be worn for training meetings, outside classes and company inspections of the district.</p> <p>Wearing of the Class A, B, or C uniform out of context will not be tolerated. <i>Example: Blue jeans and Class B shirt. Class D shirts may be worn leisurely on non-fire district related duties.</i></p> <p>The Fire District issues this clothing to you to promote a positive and professional image to the people of this community. If you have problems with any part of your uniform contact the Supply Officer for assistance.</p> <p><b><u>INSIGNIAS</u></b> All members who hold the rank of Sergeant or above will wear the appropriate rank insignia in conjunction with the Class A or B uniform as indicated on the illustration attached. (<i>See Figure 5.1 for correct placement</i>)</p> <p><b><u>BADGE</u></b> The badge is to be worn above the left breast pocket.</p> <p><b><u>NAME PLATE</u></b> The name plate is to be worn even with the right breast pocket, the years of service plate will overlap the pocket material.</p> <p><b><u>AWARDS</u></b> The Fire District Years of Service Pin shall be worn 1" above the name plate.</p> <p><b><u>EMT INSIGNIA</u></b> The EMT pin is to be worn below the name-plate centered on the pocket flap.</p> <p>Enclosure (<a href="#">Figure 5.1</a>)</p>
